

7th Annual Boy Scout Camp-Out Ferrari Racing Days May 16, 17, 18, 2014

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. Boy Scouts of America troops across California are welcome to sign up and attend the 2014 Ferrari Racing Days on May 16, 17, 18, and camp at Mazda Raceway Laguna Seca. Space is limited to 250 campers. Troops are required to Pre-Register. Minimum age for campers is 9 years old.
- 2. All Campers will need a ticket regardless of age. Packets will be mailed to the Troop Leader Contact stated on the Sign-Up Sheet containing vouchers designated "Chaperone" and "Scout" approximately four weeks prior to the event. Vouchers <u>must</u> be exchanged for tickets when you arrive. Packets will include one overnight vehicle pass per chaperone (see #7).
- 3. This is an opportunity for a group outing for your Boy Scout Troop and/or Cub Scout Pack. The promotion is not valid for individual Boy Scout/Cub Packs and/or parents. Troop/Pack leaders must sign up for the troop.
- 4. Groups must consist of at least four Scouts and one Chaperone for ages above 13 years old. Any group between 9-12 years old must consist of at least two Scouts and one Chaperone.
- 5. Camping and Admission for participating troops is FREE. One Chaperone ticket will be issued for every four scouts, or two chaperones for every two scouts. Additional chaperone 3-Day General Admission and Paddock tickets can be purchased for a reduced price of \$20. Deadline to purchase at this price is April 11, 2014. After April 11, tickets must be purchased from the Mazda Raceway Laguna Seca Ticket Office at the regular advance price, and will not include overnight vehicle or camping passes.
- 6. Tent Camping will be located in the Grand Prix Campground. This area is subject to change. Grand Prix are numbered sites, and site will be first come/first serve. Picnic tables and barbeque pits are in each site. Campfires are not allowed on the ground.
- 7. One overnight vehicle pass will be provided for each Chaperone. Each vehicle must have an overnight parking pass to stay overnight. If a vehicle is parked overnight without a pass, the vehicle will be towed at the owner's expense.
